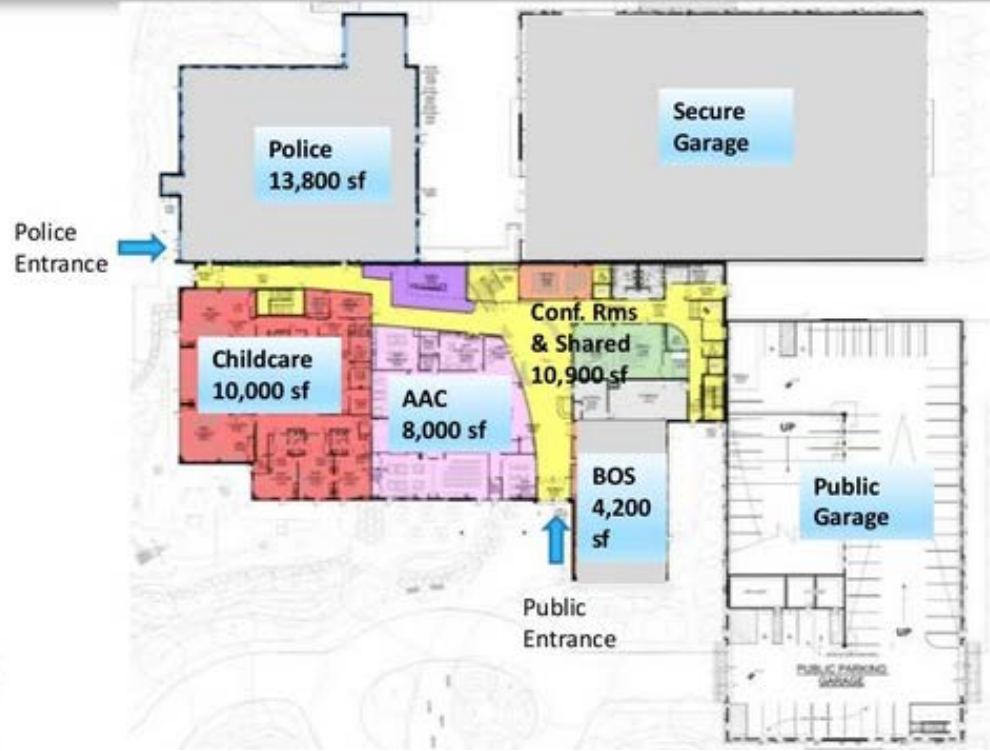

Franconia Government Center and Kingstowne Regional Library New Building



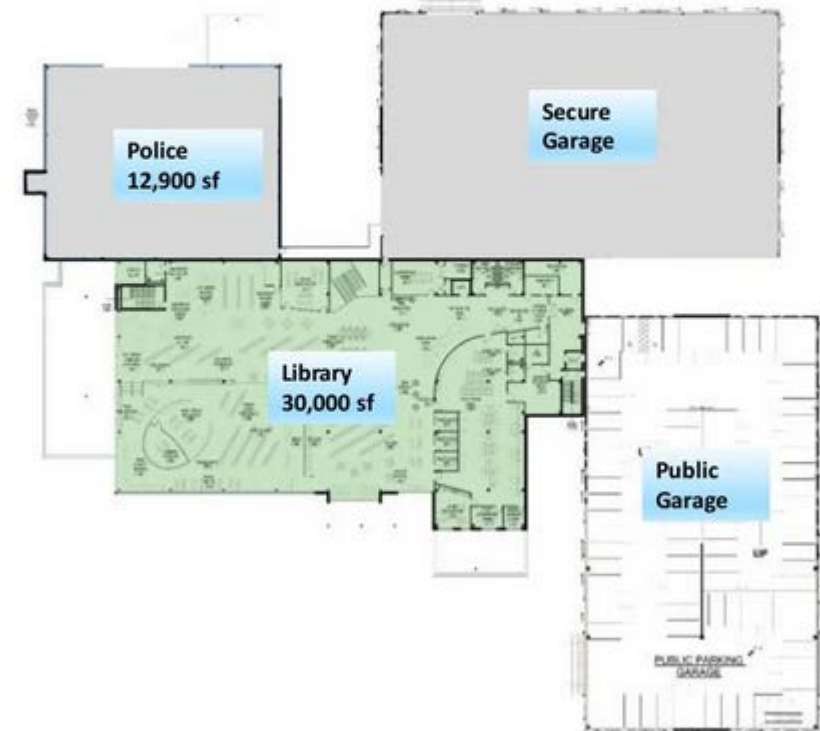
Construction estimated 2023-2024

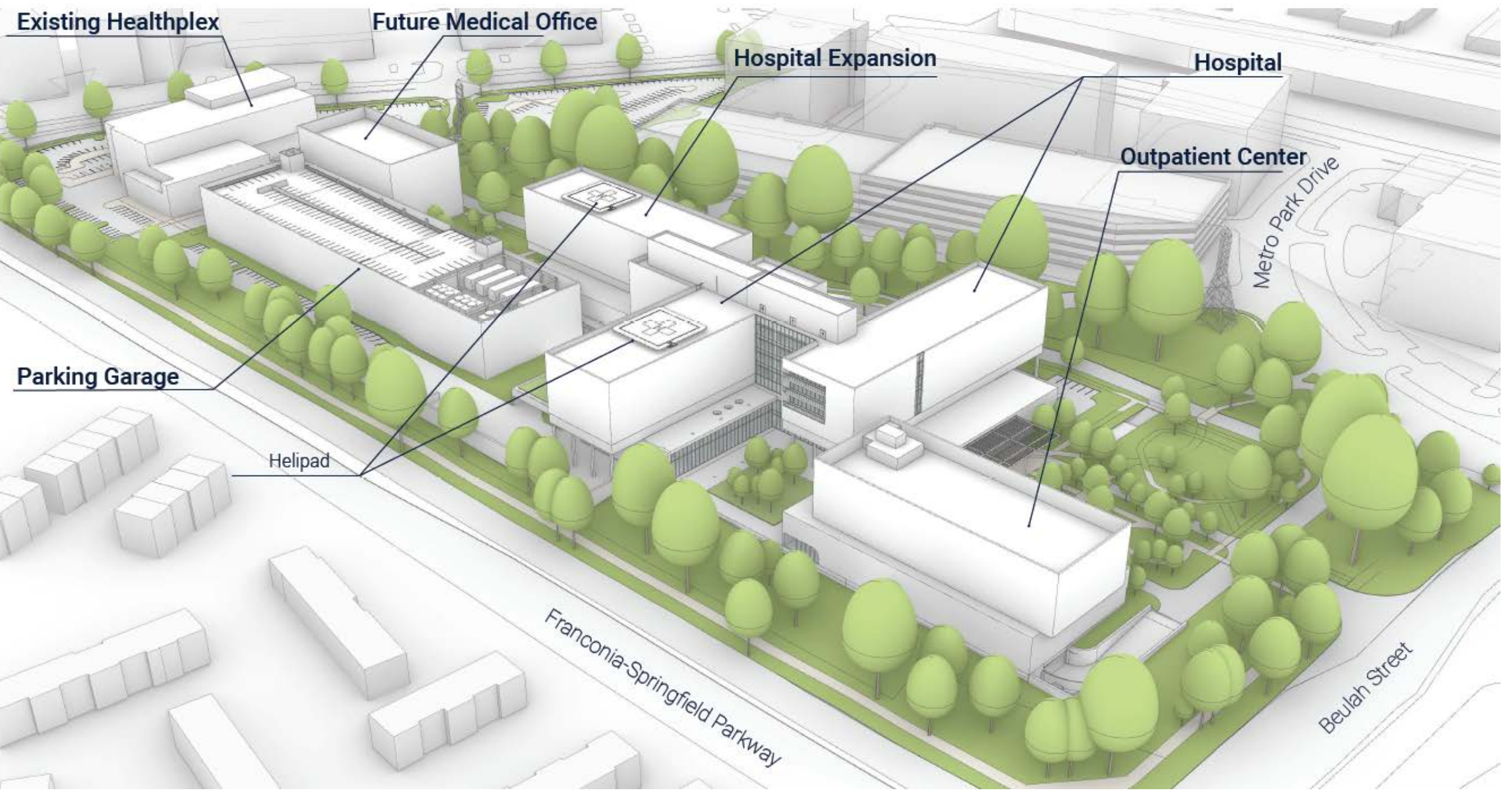

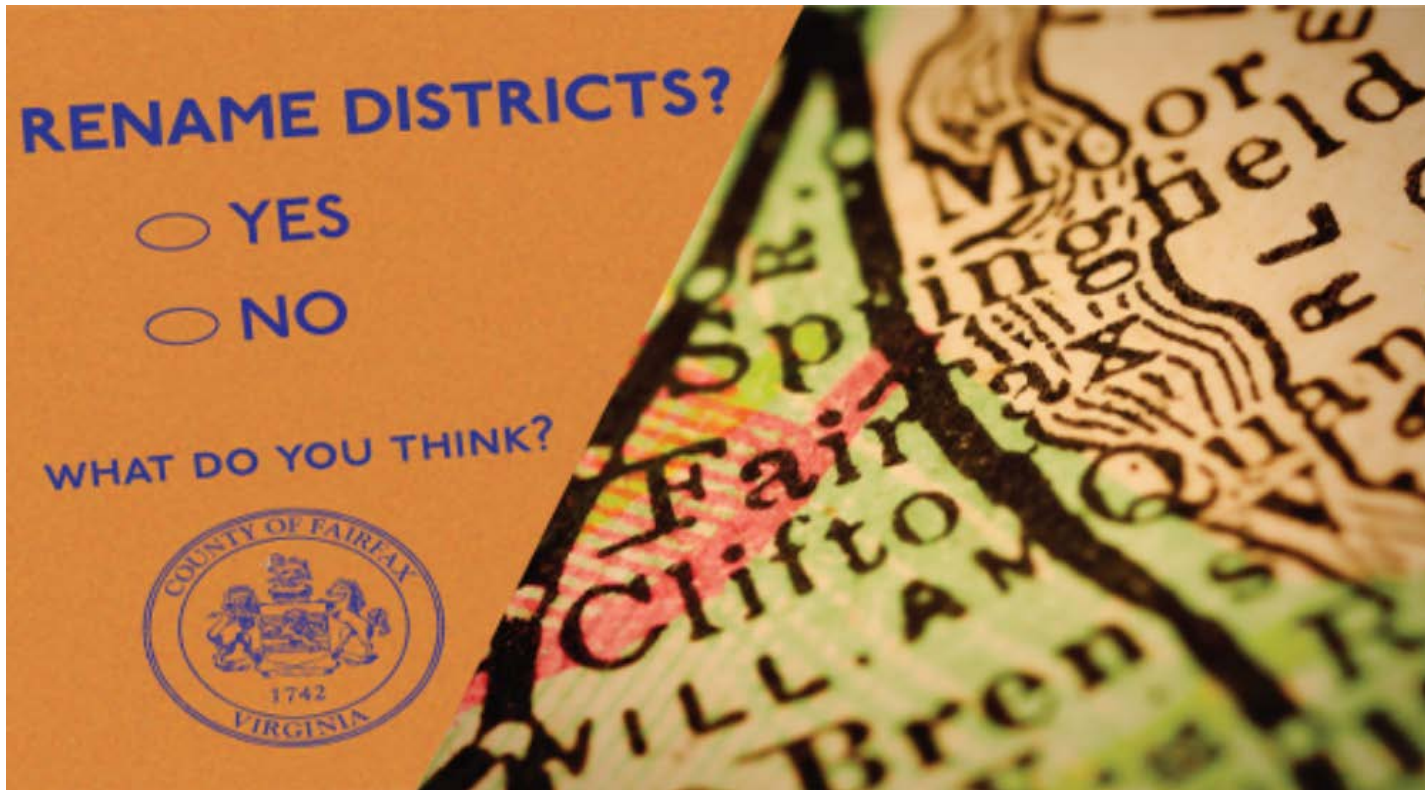

- Associated with the Confederacy, segregation, Jim Crow, racism, discrimination or slave ownership**
